FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Glen Lake Camp and Retreat Center wants to see your Student/Youth Ministry strengthen relationships and grow deeper through the love of Jesus Christ. You and your church are invited to join us for unique adventures your students will remember for years to come at **WINTER CAMP!** Below are some answers to some questions you might have.

How do we register? Our website, www.glenlake.org/wintercamp contains all the registration links and forms necessary for Winter Camp. Registration is currently open and will stay open until camp is full or until two weeks prior to camp starting.

Who can go? Youth in grades 6-12 (of this school year). Adults who have completed the five-steps of the MinistrySafe certification and training through their local church. Groups need to provide 1 gender specific adults for every 8 gender specific students. If your group includes both boys and girls, you must bring at least one male adult and one female adult for every 8 students/ If you have 10 female students and 17 male students, you will need to bring 2 female adults and three male adults. The MinistrySafe Compliance form will be due two weeks prior to the event.

Why a Group Registration and Individual Registration? Winter Camp is about the students/youth ministry thriving through a shared conference style experience. Participants must attend with their church. Group registration will allow Glen Lake Camp to make initial plans considering the capacity of each Winter Camp Weekend. We will communicate directly with Group Leaders on Winter Camp updates. Group Registration does not require a deposit and does not reserve a number of spots for your group. Get your group registered now and get your individuals registered when individual registration opens on October 6th. Group Registration will allow for your students to register for camp when individual registration opens.

How much does Winter Camp cost? \$165.00 for each participant.

What is included in the cost? Do we need to bring additional spending money? Your fee covers lodging, curriculum and supplies, our worship band and speaker, meals while at camp (Saturday breakfast, lunch, dinner, Sunday breakfast) You may wish to bring additional money to purchase snacks and Glen Lake Camp gear from the camp store. Keep in mind, if you are getting dinner or lunch with your students before or after, need to rent a vehicle, you might want to prepare for that now to give yourself plenty of time before our weekend together..

Where will we sleep? Everyone will sleep in cabins at Glen Lake Camp and Retreat Center. Participants will be assigned cabins based on church and gender, with at least two non-related adults of the same gender in the cabin. The cabins are modern, with electricity, showers, bathrooms, heating/air. Participants will sleep in individual twin size bunk beds. You will need to provide your own bedding

What do we bring? Before Winter Camp, you will be emailed a detailed 'What to Bring' list.

What is the Cell Phone Policy? Cell phones may be brought to Winter Camp, but it is our hope you will leave them in the cabins. Glen Lake Camp is a great place to be free of distractions and tune into the Holy Spirit.

What is the Medication Policy? Churches should follow their local church medication procedures. Group leaders will be responsible for the Group's medications. Glen Lake Camp will not dispense medications (prescription or over-the-counter). All medications should be in a locked and secure location.
